Addie Lee Mitchell, affectionately known as “Big Ma” or “Big Mama”, was born January 9, 1933 in Opelika, Alabama to parents Asbury Harris and Everlena Patrick Harris. She moved to Oakland, Florida in her early twenties where she met her forever sister-friend, Eddie R. Jackson. She also met James Mitchell and they married in 1955.

Addie was the eldest of her six siblings, therefore she was unable to attend school during her primary years due to having to work and help support the family. She was a “Go Getter” and was extremely motivated. With a high school-aged teenager by her side, she attended night school and graduated along with her one and only daughter, Patricia, in 1970 from Charles R. Drew High School.

Addie was very resourceful with several abilities. She served in the restaurant and hospitality industry for 23 years, having excelled in her career at both Sunland Hospital and Walt Disney World. Addie was known to spread love and joy through cooking, baking and serving others. Everyone had their favorite dish, but her specialties were banana pudding, bread pudding and her famous pound cake.

Addie attended Mt. Zion A.M.E. Church in Oakland, Florida and served faithfully on the Minnie Holmes Usher Ministry, Choir, WMS (Women’s Ministry Society) and the Pastor’s Aide. She also served as Treasurer of the County Wide Charity Club (CWCC) until her health began to fail.
