Adolph Armstrong, Sr. was born on December 31, 1945 in Thomasville, Georgia to the late Lonnie Armstrong and Nancy Barton. He attended public school in Apopka and Mt. Dora, Florida.

Adolph was a hard worker and would employ anyone. He taught his children and the grandchildren the value of work. He had various jobs throughout his lifetime which included clearing trees, working with his stepfather picking oranges and apples. He also worked a security officer and retired at a Tree Surgeon in 2007.

He became a member of the Lord's Church on October 6, 1996. at the 10th Street Church of Christ in Apopka. He was earnest about his commitment to Christ. Upon being baptized, the minister emerged him twice to ensure that his body was completely covered. Brother Armstrong has remained faithful until his demise.

He loved working in the church and served on the finance, benevolence, and van driver committee. He was famous for cooking delicious barbeque pig feet and bread putting.
