Al Gary Cooper was born on February 20, 1954 in Orlando, Florida, to the proud parents, Charlie Cooper and Daisy Bell Williams. Al was a robust, athletic, very smart and mischievous individual as a child. He attended Orange County Public Schools and graduated from Jones High School.

Al joined the United States Army, traveling throughout the country, receiving several medals and awards for his excellent service. He served also as a hospital administrator specialist.
