Alice Faye Haskell James was born February 17, 1941 in Winter Garden, Florida to Lilla Mae Boulter and Albert Zackery and lived there for most of her life. She was the first grandchild of William and Carrie Boulter of Winter Garden, Florida. As a young teenager, she lived with her uncle and aunt, William and Mary Boulter in Chicago and was raised with her cousins, Harold, Preston, Billy Richard, Roxanne, and Michael. She returned to Winter Garden, Florida where she graduated from Drew High School, class of 1958.

Alice Faye accepted the Lord as her Personal Savior at an early age, under the leadership of the late Reverend F. E. Wilder of Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church. She was an original and loyal member of Martin Luther King, Jr Memorial Choir, whose mission was to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ through song.

She loved dancing and listening to music and she and Carl were known to have thrown a party or two. She was a good mother, grandmother, neighbor, and friend who was well-known throughout the community. Alice Faye loved to travel. Alice Faye retired from the Quality Health Care Center in Winter Garden and moved to Orlando, where she lived until the Lord called her home.
