Ancel George Robinson, affectionately known as "Robbie", was born on March 1st, 1926 in Chapelton, Jamaica to Thomas Robinson and Albertina Robotham. He passed away on the afternoon of Monday, October 10th, 2022 which would have been his beloved wife Sylvia's 93rd birthday.

Growing up, he attended Wolmers and went on to graduate from Excelsior High School. After graduation, he immediately started working. He ultimately began employment at the Agricultural Development Corporation (ADC) where he was the Head of Machine Maintenance. Sometime in the early 50's he met the love of his life, Sylvia Delores Browne and in 1952, they were married. They had 5 beautiful children-Tony, Charmaine, Trevor, Richard and finally Carol.
