Annie Dell Neal Massey (aka, Frizz) was born on April 25, 1929 in Winter Garden, Florida to her parents Willie James Neal, Sr. and Elnora Horton Neal, both deceased. She was the youngest of 3 children, two of whom preceded her in death; Willie James Neal, Jr., and Mary Helen Neal. At the passing of her only sister, whom passed on at an early age, she and her cousin Geneva formed a special bond just like sisters.

Frizz received her early education at Hungerford Boarding School; where she was the Valedictorian of her 8th grade class. She was an avid reader; which she passed on to her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. She also enjoyed fishing, as she took her grandchildren with her every chance she got. Although she couldn't swim, that did not stop her from teaching her grandkids to fish; all she needed was her hoe to kill off the moccasins when they invaded her space.

In 1946, she married K. C. Massey, (who preceded her in death) and from this union her legacy began with Reginald, Van, and Carl. Later in life, she would give birth to 6 additional children that would further continue her legacy.

On Sunday, November 10, 2019, she received a call from her boss that her assignment here on earth was complete and that she would be coming home to reunite with her family she missed so much. There would be eating,

dancing, laughing, and lots of fishing. She quietly said goodbye and took her seat on flight 1110 to eternity.
