Mr. Ayron Jamal Cannady was born on September 14, 1992, in Orlando, FL to Mr. Horace and Mrs. Janice Cannady, Jr. Even though he was born premature and weighed only 4 lbs and 10 oz, he certainly overcame his small stature as he grew in height to 6'4"! He was affectionately nicknamed "Ayrie" and "Awish" and was a professed "Mama's boy" and was proud of it and didn't care who knew it! He had a very friendly and welcoming personality as everyone he met, he considered a friend. He greeted everyone with a hug and a smile, and he enjoyed spending time with his cousins as they were more like his brothers and sisters because they were so close-knit. Mr. Cannady enjoyed watching football and his favorite NFL team was the Green Bay Packers (especially when they won). He also enjoyed playing basketball and his favorite NBA team was the Grizzlies (Jon Morant), and if he was not playing basketball on the court, he was playing online with the NBA 2K '23 video game. He often talked about starting his own lawn maintenance business as he aspired to be a business owner. He was an inspirational and motivational speaker to his nieces and nephews and was often overheard telling them to always listen to their parents and do your best in school because he wanted them to do better than he did as he learned many lessons the hard way. Ayron had a talent for making people laugh and was often told that he could be a standup comedian as he had the ability to make jokes off the cuff. He was wise beyond his years and on many occasions talked to his friends about God and would find himself giving his friends the same advice that his parents gave him. In April of 2013

at the age of 21, Ayron made the most important decision of his life and that was to accept Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior and was baptized at Ninth Street Church of Christ. 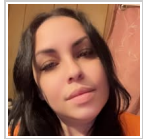
