Pastor Bertha Mae Smith Wynn was born on October 22, 1938 to Esco Smith, Sr. and Mildred (Wallace) Smith in Soperton, Georgia. She was married to Eddie Lee Wynn in August 1954 in Mayfield, New York. The family moved to Apopka, Florida in the early fifties. She was a native of Apopka, Florida and the mother of five children. She attended Phyllis Wheatley and studied for her GED later in life.

She worked at Orange Memorial Hospital as a Certified Nurses Assistant on the night shift for 10 years then worked at Disney World Food Industry in the early seventies, she then became a housewife.

In her younger years she attended St. Elizabeth Holiness Church. She was a member of Light House Tabernacle of Prayer before going into full time

ministry. She was baptized and introduced to the Lord Jesus Christ. She loved the Lord and devoted and surrendered her entire life to the service of the Lord. She accepted the call of Jesus Christ to preach the Gospel and was an Evangelist for a season then Pastored “Temple of the Living God for All People” in Apopka, Florida for approximately 25 years. She later attended “Tabernacle of Prayer Mission Church” under Dover Wynn, Jr., Pastor.

Pastor Wynn was preceded in death by her parents: Esco Smith, Sr. and Mildred (Wallace) Williams; two brothers: Jimmy Smith, George Washington; one sister: Lenora Givens; brother-in-law, Joe Aponte; son-in-law: Reverend Cato L. Mott., Sr. and grandson: Joshua J. Mott.
