Brandon Charles Lynum was born April 17, 1987 to Willie & Eloise Lynum in Limestone, Maine. He grew up in Montclair Village also known as 468/Red Road and attended Lake County Public schools. Brandon was a man of many talents. He was a local rapper with Burg City, and his occupation was a used car salesman where he would buy, sell or trade, to many. Brandon was known as Ratchett City, B Rad, or Red Dog, but most importantly he was known as a good friend, a faithful brother, and a loving son one who would do whatever he could to keep a smile on the face of many even though he was going through his own pain. His greatest joy was spending time with his family and friends.

Brandon was diagnosed with cancer in 2017, but the diagnosis didn't change his spirit. Through it all he still kept a smile on his face, because it was more important for him to see others smile. His infectious smile and positive attitude inspired and encouraged so many throughout his battle.

Brandon's biggest accomplishment in life was when he decided to give his life to Christ. He left the old him behind and became a new creation in Christ. Prior to Brandon's transition, he assured everyone he was alright, "God's Got Me" as he would often say letting everyone know he was safe in the hands of the Lord, and his appointment with heaven was already made and we could rest assured that he would be seated in the presence of the King.

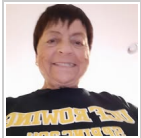
