Brenda Elaine Rose was born in Apopka, Florida on September 25, 1946, the third of seven children born to Mattie Henry Rose and Willie Fred Rose, Sr. Brenda accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior as a young child and was baptized into the Kingdom of God at St. Paul A.M.E. Church in Apopka. Church was an integral part of her early life. She participated in many youth activities at St. Paul including the Young People Department, Allen Christian Fellowship, Youth Choirs, Church School, and all the activities on the district and conference levels of the A.M.E. Church. She often spoke lovingly of the enjoyment of those church activities from her youth.

Brenda attended Phillis Wheatley School from 1st through 12th grade. After graduating from Phillis Wheatley High School in 1964, Brenda attended and graduated from Barber College in Jacksonville, FL. She worked as a barber for several years before deciding to attend Florida Technological University (UCF), graduating with a degree in Elementary Education. She taught elementary school students in Orange County Public School for over 20 years. She was adamant in her belief that all children were important and capable of learning.

She enjoyed dancing, telling jokes, and dressing in pretty clothes and shoes. Brenda said she was not properly dressed if she did not have "hair pretties" on her head. Her mother often said Brenda would cry when she was a child if she did not have ribbons in her hair. She continued that tradition throughout life and always wore hair pretties to accent her style. She was an expert gardener, decorator and cook. Others often sought advice from Brenda on how to keep plants healthy, how to decorate spaces in any room and how to cook her extensive array of special dishes. Brenda lived in England for over 19 years and was a worldwide traveler. She was married to Nathaniel Stephens and Jason Conrad.

She was preceded in death by her loving parents, Willie and Mattie Rose, her sister Vera Rose Poitier, and brothers Maxey Stanley Rose and Willie Fred Rose, Jr.
