Evangelist Carrie Lee Mills Allen was born in Morgan, Georgia, on November 16, 1944 to Willie Lee Mills and Ora Pearl (Crapps) Mills.

Evangelist Allen attended Orange County Public Schools (Charles R. Dre, Winter Garden, Florida).

Evangelist Allen accepted Christ at an early age and became a dedicated member of Trinity Missionary Baptist Church, Oakland, Florida for over 50 years. Evangelist Allen served Trinity as the Chairlady for the Senior Citizens Program, singing in the Adult Choir, attending and teaching Sunday School; Chairperson for the Sisterhood Committee; Beautification Committee; Kitchen Committee and Deaconess Board.

On March 9, 1961 she was united in holy matrimony to her husband Benjamin C. Allen and to this union three children were born, Ronnie Allen, Timothy Allen and Katrina Allen. She became the first lady of New Bethel Missionary Baptist Church Wildwood, Florida in 1995 when her husband was called to

Pastorship. She served in full capacity as First Lady as well as used her gift of singing in the Adult Choir.

Evangelist Allen worked for over ten years at the Navy Base in Orlando, Florida, she retired from Orange County Public Schools where she worked for over ten years at Lake Silver Elementary.

Evangelist Allen whom many called Auntie was known for her special tea cakes. Evangelist Allen loved spending time with her grand and great grandchildren. She loved sewing, making floral arrangement and working outside in her yard.
