Reed was raised by his paternal grandparents the late Amy and Joe Reed. He received his education in the Berrien County School System and served a tour duty in the U.S Army. Rev. Reed was employed by Golden Triangle Builders Supply which was sold to RoMac Lumber and retired in 1996. Having accepted Christ at an early age at Immanuel Baptist Church in Nashville Georgia. He knew he was not only called but chosen by God to preach the Gospel message. Rev. Reed received seminary training in the AME church, and after several appointments he joined the Free Methodist Church under the guidance of the Late Rev. Norman R. McNair and was installed as Pastor of Royal Temple in April of 1968 and served faithfully for 38 years and retired in December of 2006. He also served several terms as President of the IFMC Council. On September 15, 1955 he was united in holy matrimony to the love of his life Gearline Reed, and to the union was born twelve children, Betty, Dorrene, Michael, Marie, Sampson, Chris, Carrol Jr. Marry, Jerena, Joyce, Jonathan, and Joshua.
