Catherine Cranford was born on September 10, 1930, in Newton, Georgia, and attended Baker County High School.

Catherine met and married the love of her life, Charlie Cranford. The two remained blissfully married for 46 years, until his passing. Catherine and her husband Charlie had no children, but together they served so many within their community. They resided in Cincinnati, Ohio, Miami Florida, and settled in Orlando, Florida. She has been a Florida resident for over 60 years.

Before retiring, she held positions as a grill cook, a domestic, and an accounting clerk at Valencia Community College East Campus.

After retiring from Valencia in 1992, she volunteered in the gift shop at Winter Park Hospital. When asked what she liked best about being an auxiliary, she said, "serving the people".

Catherine was very active in many organizations and clubs. Before her health failed, she was the Mother of her church, Beth Tehillah Ministries. For many years, she was a member of Mt. Moriah Missionary Baptist Church in Winter Park, Florida. Having such a servant heart, she served in many capacities within her church and community organizations. She served Superintendent of Sunday school, past president of the church's Nurses Guild Ministry,

Financial Secretary of the Sanctuary Choir, President of the Pastor's Aide Ministry, member of the First South Florida Association of Nurses Ministry, Treasurer of the State of Florida M & E Convention Nurses, Corresponding Secretary of the Baptist Training Union Congress, State of Florida. Member of the Ideal Women's Club of Winter Park, member of AARP, and Senior Friends.

Catherine was also a loyal member of her Fraternal Organization, Royal Grand Chapter Order of the Eastern Star, State of Florida. Worthy Matron of Brantley M. Jordan #90, Winter Park, District Deputy #10, and Honorary Grand Worthy Matron. A member of the Hannah B. Miller Sun Beams Youth Department Order of the Eastern Star.
