Charles Harold Roux also known as Uncle Halley and Cousin Halley, was born July 28, 1913 in Lake City, Florida. He was the fifth child born to John and Frances Roux. His siblings were John, William, Rosa, Queen, Ester, Frank, Theodore and Leon Roux. Charles was baptized at William Chapel Missionary Baptist Church at a young age.

The family moved to Sanford, Florida in 1926 and later to Altamonte Springs, Florida, which became his permanent residence.

Harold and Minnie were the owners of Take A Chance Restaurant for over forty years. He was the 1st black used car salesperson for Jesse Dykes Motors. He made it possible for many people to purchase a car.

In 1940 Harold married Minnie Foster, this union lasted seventy years. Harold believed the keys to success were to have a good work ethic, family values and help your community. May the Work I've Done Speak for Me.

He was preceded in death by his wife Minnie Roux, parents, John and Frances Roux, and all of his siblings.

On Thursday, March 26, 2014, The Lord in His infinite wisdom deemed it timely to call from our midst our beloved Charles Harold Roux. His departure

is a deep and personal loss to his family and friends and he will be greatly missed by them all.
