Charlsie Byrd Otieno was born in Clem, Georgia on March 1, 1949 to the late Raymond and Juanita Byrd. She was number nine of the “just ten” Byrd clan: Clestelle Hunt, Idella

Beasley (Thomas), Raymond Byrd Jr. (Monica), Wyona “Peachye” Crowder (Howard), Bettye “Bunchye” Roberts (Samuel), Frankye Pope, Alfred Byrd (Carolyn), Charles Byrd (Emma) and Garvin Byrd (Natalie). She was introduced to God at a very early age, as she watched her parents live out the greatest commandments to love The Lord and your neighbor! She was educated in the public schools of Carroll County, Georgia, graduating with Honors from Carver High School. She was also crowned Miss Carver High School (1966). She later attended Georgia State University in Atlanta, Georgia and Seminole

State College in Orlando, Florida. Charlsie was a devoted member of New Life Christian Center of Orlando under Pastors Henry and Gloria Jones. She was ordained as a Minister in 2002, and faithfully served as leader of the BuilderCare Outreach Ministry, teacher of both the Sunday School and New Builders Orientation Class and a member of the Board of Directors.
