I will miss the banter of two old friends reminiscing when he and Glenn spoke or got together. I will miss his southern hospitality and his ability to bring up any movie or TV show on the planet with his remote and I will miss his winter phone calls.

Above all that simply put, we will miss you Clarence being on this planet and being a part of our lives .We will see you on the other side someday .Godspeed , Dear Clarence ,Godspeed .
