D.S. (Nathaniel) SUMMERS was born in St. George, South Carolina on April 19, 1937 to Shelly and Ora Summers. He was their third child. His father, Shelly Summers Sr. and Ora Summers were born in St. George SC. On September 1949 at the age of 36, while living in Mappsville Virginia, Shelly was tragically killed in a car accident. He was a Serious and Dedicated man. Once he said it, it was going happen! Whatever he said, he believed in what he was talking about. If Nathaniel said, "I was going to whip you" then he was going to whip you. Nathaniel built his life around his community, church and family.

COMMUNITY

He believed in giving everyone the RESPECT due to them. He said, "You respect everybody, and you expect them to respect you." As a friend and neighbor, he always made himself available to assist others. Nathaniel would always make it his business to lend a helping hand to others. Every voting season he would round up the elderly and take them to vote. When church was over, he would stay behind to make sure all tasks was completed. He would not leave until everything was accounted for. He loved his church, pastor and above all the Word of God.
