



## Denfield Hughlester Browne

May 4, 1944 - July 12, 2024

Denfield Hughlester Browne, age 80, of St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, transitioned to glory on Friday, July 12, 2024. Denfield was born May 4, 1944, in Parham, Antigua, West Indies, to the late Joseph and Edna Browne. He had fifteen siblings: nine sisters and six brothers. He juggled attending Parham School while working on the family's farm, which is now run by two of his siblings Genevieve and Celester Browne.

Denfield became a father in 1965 when his first child, Yvette Browne was born to Rachel "Mona" Green. In 1971, their son, Wayne Browne, was born. Denfield moved to St. Croix and then to St. Thomas, where he met and married Sandra Browne (deceased). Their marriage produced a daughter, Letitia Browne-James. He was also dedicated to his three stepchildren: Andrea Williams, Michelle Bell, and Duane Bell.

A man of faith. Denfield remained a dedicated member of the Faith Christian Fellowship Church Alive in Christ for 40 years. Throughout his life, he enjoyed a varied mix of professions. Denfield was a carpenter at the Mill Reef, a dreger at St. Johns in Antigua, and later a meat mutter at Merchant's Market in St. Thomas. He then thrived in his career as a Taxi driver at Islanders Taxi for 30 years until his retirement. Always willing to help others, in the 1990's, Denfield took on a role at the Virgin Island Water and Power Authority to assist in post-hurricane recovery efforts.

Denfield enjoyed music, socializing, history, politics, mechanics, and carpentry. He was independent, funny, strong-willed, and caring. He loved his children, grandchildren, great- grandchildren, and other family and friends, too numerous to mention . He served as a father figure to many people throughout his life and will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.

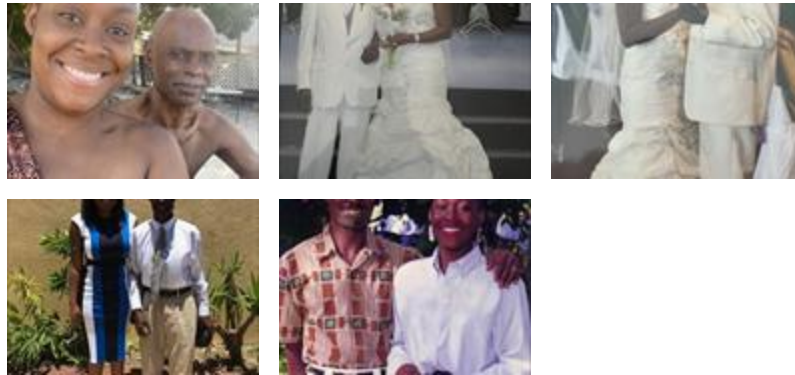
