Doris Alberta Singleton Morall was born February 16, 1938 on Union Ridge, TN to the late Willie E. McMahon and Ernest Singleton. She received her education on "The Ridge" and at Bedford County Training School (with Arena Groves by her side from 1st grade through college). Doris graduated Salutatorian of her high school class and matriculated at Tennessee State University in Nashville, TN, where she met and married the love of her life, Ben Morall Jr. They shared nearly 50 years of matrimony before he passed on in 2009. They both graduated from TSU with Bachelor Degrees.

While living in Florida, which was Ben's home, Doris worked in accounting at Minute Maid, Walt Disney World, and Martin Marietta. She later became the CEO of New World Services, Inc., one of the first minority-owned companies to garner a contract with NASA. She was a faithful member of Our Savior Lutheran Church in Orlando, FL for over 40 years, and later of Living Water Community Church. She continued her faith walk and charitable contributions in Gwinnett County, GA and Shelbyville, TN.

She is survived by her children: Deniya of Mableton, GA, Wendelyn of Duluth, GA, Monica Morall-Baker (Dwight) of Buford, GA, and Ben III (Edwina) of Lawrenceville, GA, and grandchildren Darius and Kierra.
