Dorothy Jean Brunson, was born on July 25, 1945 in Arlington, Georgia, to David and Annie Lee Ransome. In 1950 the family relocated to Winter Garden, Florida. Dorothy attended grades 1-12 at Charles R. Drew, where she excelled academically and in sports. She was a star basketball player for the "Mighty Wildcats." She graduated from Charles R. Drew High School in the class of 1963. Upon graduation, Dorothy obtained employment at Maxey Elementary in the cafeteria, working in the cafeteria at Maxey Elementary. After several years, she attended Westside Vocational Technical and received her license in cosmetology. Later she returned to the Orange County School System as a bus driver.
