Mrs. Dorothy Jean Dowdell Hughley was born September 25, 1950, in Tuskegee, Alabama at John Andrew Hospital to parents, Pompey Lee Dowdell and Rebecca Bailey Dowdell. She attended J.F. Drake High School in Auburn, Alabama and graduated in the Class of 1968.

After high school, Dorothy attended Florida A&M University and worked at Marvin C. Zanders Funeral Home here in Apopka, Florida. She later worked for the Apopka Police Department, where she was the first black female police officer.

Dorothy married Roosevelt Hughley in 1972 at the Orange County Courthouse in Orlando, Florida, sharing a beautiful love and life for 48 years. She was a homemaker, faithful wife, and a powerful woman of God, that was devoted to ministry as an evangelist alongside her husband. She and her husband were members of Church of God by Faith in Winter Park and Apopka, Florida and later became members of Church In The Son in Orlando, Florida for over 20 years.

On Thursday, January 12, 2023, Mrs. Dorothy Hughley closed her eyes and slept peacefully into eternity with the Lord.

She was preceded in death by her Husband, Evangelist Roosevelt Hughley

and her Father and Mother, Pompey Lee Dowdell and Rebecca Bailey Dowdell.
