Dorothy Mae Paul, previously known as Dorothy Mae Shaw, was born on October 2, 1933, in Quincy, Florida, to Ira and Dora Shaw, Being the oldest of three daughters. Dorothy was raised in a loving home filled with joy and strong religious beliefs. During her youth, she found pleasure in playing softball and assisting with her parents farm. Dorothy was educated in her Gadsden County Public school system.

In 1942, Dorothy met the love of her life, James Robert Paul, Sr. while working as parents on the tobacco farm. Dorothy and James fell in love and were wed on September 11, 1948. James and Dorothy moved to Narcoossee, Florida in 1952. Prior to moving to Narcoossee, they had four kids. James and Dorothy settled in Narcoossee where they had six additional children, and were married for 75 years. Dorothy prided herself on being a devoted wife, mother of 10 kids, and grandmother of 70 plus. Dorothy was a loving mother who knew each of her children in her own way. She taught her children about life experiences and instilled values of honesty and respect in them.

Dorothy started her career as a domestic worker, cleaning homes for several years before securing a permanent position as a cook with Tupperware. She worked at Tupperware for 22 years before retiring at the age of 63. After retiring, Dorothy focused on raising five of her grandchildren and taking care of the household.

Dorothy was firm, but loving. She had no problem sharing how she felt about you and what was on her mind. Dorothy was a social butterfly and knew no strangers. Dorothy could often be spotted in public settings sharing a smile and striking up a conversation. Dorothy loved sharing sayings about life, and cooking. Dorothy was an avid speller. You would often find Dorothy at home watching Walter Texas Ranger and Wheel of Fortune, or listening to Kenny G. Dorothy loved a good laugh and cherished time with her family. Dorothy was a Deaconess at the St. Luke Missionary Baptist Church of Narcoossee, and was the oldest African American resident of the Whitted Historic Community in Narcoossee. Most of all, Dorothy loved her "Man" and felt most complete when they were together. James was called home to be with Lord on February 19, 2024, and the Lord in his infinite wisdom chose to reunite James and Dorothy five months later on July 23, 2024. What a mighty God we serve.

Dorothy was preceded in death Her devoted Husband, James Robert Paul, Sr.; Her loving Parents. Ira and Dora Shaw; Two Sisters, Gertrude Scott, and Thelma Sweet; Three Children, Melvin Paul, Curtis Paul, and Brenda Paul; and Great Grandson, Hassaun Ortiz.

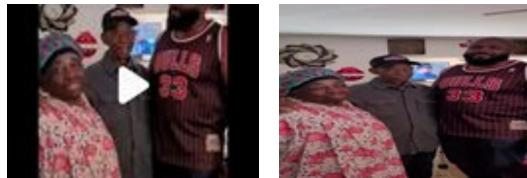
