On July 31, 1951, Eugene Harry Johnson, Jr. was born in Cheyenne, Wyoming, to the loving union of Eugene and Melvilan Johnson. Affectionately known as "BeBe" to his family and "Bowleg" to his friends, Eugene was the second oldest of nine children and a source of strength, wisdom, and laughter within his family.

Eugene was educated in the Miami-Dade County Public School system and graduated from Miami Jackson High School in June 1970, where he proudly represented the Jackson Generals. During his youth, he met the love of his life, Alfreda Oliver. Their bond, which began at the age of fourteen, blossomed into a lifelong partnership. They were united in holy matrimony on May 18, 1973, in Miami, Florida, and shared over five decades of love, commitment, and devotion. He was loyal to his friends, deeply respected by his siblings, and valued by all who knew him. He lived his life grounded in faith and maintained a personal relationship with the Lord.

Eugene found joy in life's simple pleasures. He loved fishing, listening to jazz music, playing billiards, dancing, solving crossword puzzles, and most importantly, spending quality time with his family. His presence brought warmth, wisdom, and joy to every room he entered.

On April 5, 2026, Eugene answered the call of the Lord and entered into eternal rest. He was preceded in death by his parents, Eugene and Melvilan Johnson, and his brother, David Johnson.
