Despite its size, Enon, Alabama is known for its big heart. Evans was the second oldest of eleven children, which included eight girls and three boys. He embraced the big brother role with tenderness and responsibility. As a loving brother, he cared for his siblings with kindness and strength.

Evans received his early education at Enon Elementary and Enon Junior High in Enon, Alabama, and completed high school at Merritt High School in Midway, Alabama. From a young age, Evans enjoyed fishing, hunting, and playing football. He had a remarkable green thumb, cultivating gardens that produced bountiful vegetables. Yet his greatest passion was music, especially playing the guitar, which brought joy to him and those around him.

With courage and determination, he relocated to Orlando, Florida where he launched a remarkable career in 1968 at Sun Bank, now Truist. Over 38 years of dedicated service, he made a significant impact before retiring on

September 1, 2003. Driven by an entrepreneurial spirit, Evans founded Turman Pest Control more than 35 years ago, creating a legacy that continues to inspire.
