He was Catholic and served as an Altar Boy to continue his upbringing, he was an usher at Holy Cross Catholic Church. He attended Catholic Schools in New York and obtained a degree at Mercy College in Marketing. He enlisted in the United States Air Force, serving his country from December 1, 1968– July 4, 1972. He retired in 2007.

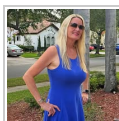
