



## Georgia Mae Bufford Morgan

November 28, 1944 - February 15, 2020

“For I am ready to be offered and the time of my departure is at hand, I have fought a good fight, and I have finished my course.” ~2 Tim. 4:6-8

Dr. Georgia Mae Morgan was born November 28, 1944, in Tuskegee, Alabama to the late George and Mae Emma Bufford. As a child, she and her family migrated to Apopka, Florida where she was raised. She later graduated from Central High School in Westmoreland, New York.

She received her Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education from Bethune Cookman College in Daytona Beach, Florida. She was a Certified Christian Counselor. She attended Canon Bible College and Seminary, where she received a Master’s Degree in Theology. She also attended Rainer Bible College, where she received a Doctorate in Religious Education; a Doctor of Theology from Homestead Bible College and a Doctor of Divinity from Jacksonville Theological Seminary in Jacksonville, Florida.

Dr. Morgan was the founder of Genesis International Ministries, Inc. in 1985. She later became the Pastor of Genesis New Birth Missionary Baptist Church where she was the first black woman to pastor a Missionary Baptist Church. She also became the first black woman to pastor a Freewill Baptist Church.

In 1995, she was called into Apostleship, traveling to Windsor, Canada where

Apostle Geraldine Carson consecrated her in the office of Apostle. In 2002, being directed by Holy Spirit, Dr. Morgan started Praise and Worship International Prophetic Ministries, where twenty-two churches (Four in Africa) served under the Praise and Worship International Prophetic Ministries. She was the founder of Genesis Counseling Center; Genesis Biblical College and Graduate School and G. M. Morgan Ministries.

Dr. Morgan dedicated her entire life to helping the poor and downtrodden. She was the mother of seven and spiritual mother and advisor to many others. Dr. Morgan was a woman who poured her life out to many. She was a walking testimony of how to serve the community. In spite of her circumstances, she still continued to serve God wholeheartedly and continually give Him praise. Dr. Morgan followed the words written by Marvin Sapp: "Never could have made it without you, I could have lost it all, but now I see that you were there for me. I'm stronger, I'm wiser, I'm better, so much better.

Dr. Morgan was preceded in death by her father, George Bufford; Mother, Mae Emma Bufford; husband, David Morgan; daughter, Chisa Wash; brothers: John Henry Bufford and JT Bufford; sisters, Willie Mae Pace and Charlotte Schouder.

Left to cherish her memory and continue in her legacy are her son, Tony Sykes (Cora) of Orlando, Florida; daughters: Roslyn T. Hamilton (Orlando), Crystal McNeal and Ms. Pat (Frank), all of Orlando, Florida; adopted daughter, Keyshonnia Morgan of Orlando, Florida; sister, Gloria Smith (Jerry) of Orlando, Florida; son-in-law, Javier Wash of Orlando, Florida; sister-in-law, Donna of Orlando, Florida; nephews: Houston Lewis, Xavier Lewis and Alfred Lewis, all of Orlando, Florida; nieces: Ilesha Bufford, Latoya Bufford, Latonya Bufford, Chermaine Bufford, Jessica Bufford-Thomas (Herman) and Tameka Bufford-Cox (Ty), all of Orlando, Florida; grandsons: Tevin Hamilton (Shakira), Justin Hamilton (Cinta) and JaQuarius McNeal, all of Orlando, Florida;
