After working hard, he enjoyed owning several homes. Harold retired at the age of 55 and moved back to Winter Park, Florida where he created a real estate portfolio of houses and apartments.

Harold always was the life of the party. He loved to laugh, own beautiful cars and motor homes, watch all sports (baseball, football and basketball), and a had a photographic memory of the statistics for major players.

He was preceded in death by his Father, Sandy Williams, Sr.; Mother, Estella Williams; Sons: Harold Michael Williams and Anthony Williams; and Brothers: Sandy Williams, Jr. and Reginald Williams.
