September 20, 1950 - January 28, 2020

On September 20, 1950, Herbert Lee Brown was the second of twin boys delivered by his mother Lottie Gordon Brown in Zellwood, Florida.

The family later moved to Tangerine Florida, where the twins attended Tangerine Elementary School. Their secondary school years were spent at Phyllis Wheatley Junior and Senior High in Apopka, Florida.

After graduating from high school, the twins parted ways. Herbert continued his education by attending Florida A and M University. His sibling enlisted into the US Army where he spent a tour in Vietnam.

Entering into the ministry, Herbert went about preaching; teaching; delivering the Word and touching many lives. He was dedicated to the work of the Lord.

In his later years, health concerns altered his life style and he eventually succumbed to an untimely death. The Lord in His infinite wisdom deemed it timely on Tuesday, January 28, 2020 to call Reverend Brown from his earthly duties to his eternal resting place with the Lord.
