



## Inetha Moore

April 30, 1928 - July 17, 2014

Inetha Moore was born April 30, 1928 to Sam and Susie Russell in Lake Panasoffkee, Florida, she was one of seven children. She accepted Christ and was baptized at the age of 12. At age 18, she was chosen to accept God’s will and purpose by receiving the baptism of the Holy Ghost. She graduated from J.R.E. Lee High School in Wildwood, Florida.
