After a brief struggle with illness, Jack Jackson, Jr. passed away peacefully at his home Wednesday, April 11th surrounded by his five children.

Born January 22, 1934 in Tangerine, Florida to Jack Jackson, Sr. and Geraldine Johnson. He was the third of seven children.

He was devoted to his family, friends and was actively involved in his Tangerine community.

He became a member and later Deacon at Greater Mt. Carmel Baptist Church in Tangerine, Florida. Jack was a long standing member of Orlando Christian Center (later Faith World) for many years. He was an active member of Saint John's Missionary Baptist Church until his illness prevented him from attending.

Education: Tangerine Elementary, Hungerford High School. Jack attended college in West Virginia and graduated Cum Laude from St. Leo University in Lakeland, Florida.

Career: Enlisted in the United States Airforce 1955-1979 and retired as Staff Sargent after 24 years of service. United States Post Office 1982 2007 with 25 years of service with a combined 49 years of service.

In 1960 while stationed at Dobbins Air Force Base in Marietta, Georgia he met and married Annette Delay, his wife of 50 years. To this union was born...The Jackson Five!

He was preceded in death by both parents: Father - Jack Jackson, Sr. and Mother - Geraldine Johnson, Wife - Annette Delay Jackson; Brother - Anthony Jackson; Sisters - Rowena Jackson, Augnese Dudley, Geraldine Freeman and LaVonia Hudson.
