In 2019, Brother James Gibson and his brother John joined the House of Ruth Empowerment Ministry and gave their lives to the Lord.

Brother Gibson worked as a dishwasher and tractor driver. He was also a great cook and prepared a full course meal for his family two weeks before his passing. On Saturday, March 21, 2020 at 10:50 a.m., Heaven’s gate swung

wide open and Brother James Gibson was called from labor to love.

Brother Gibson was preceded in death by his parents: Robert Holloway and Ada Gibson.
