Jesse Lee Brown was born on April 30, 1944, in Kissimmee, Florida, to Herman Brown and Rosa Lee Brown. Jesse attended Kissimmee High School, where he was an active member of the baseball and basketball teams, graduating in 1962.

Shortly after, in 1965, he answered the call to serve his country by joining the Army. Jesse served honorably in Korea until 1967, when he was discharged with commendation for his dedication and service. In the late 1960s, Jesse married Carolyn Brown. Together, they had three beautiful children.

Jesse had a deep interest in cattle, which led him to start working for the livestock market in the late 60s. His passion for cattle grew over the years, and he embraced the life of a cattleman with dedication and pride.
