Joan attended the Morgan's Forest Basic School 1973-1976, Morgan's Forest Primary 1976 - 1979, Aenon Town all ages 1979 - 1985, St. Monica Business School 1987 - 1989, Catering School 1990-1991, School of Cosmetology 1995-1996.

After graduating Cosmetology School, Joan was always a Sole Proprietor. She offered Cosmetology services up until 2018. She spent half of her life in Clarendon, then she moved to St. Ann in search of more work opportunities. In 2019 Joan married her fiancé Mr. Harold Hemmings. In 2020 she immigrated to the United States to be with her husband. After settling in the United States, she secured a job with the School Board.

She was diagnosed with stage 4 breast cancer. After several rounds of chemo, months of battling mentally, physically and emotionally, she succumbed to her illness, on September 30, 2022.
