The sunrise began for Joseph Burns, Sr., affectionately known as "Joe", on February 20, 1934 in Orlando, Florida to parents Deacon Benjamin Burns, Sr. and Sister Annie Williams Burns.

Educational Journey

Joe's educational journey began at the Holden Street Elementary School and graduated from the "Historic and Great" Jones High School in Orlando, Florida. He was a proud graduate of the Class of 1952. His class was the last to graduate in the "Old Jones High School Building" located on Parramore Street (in the Callahan Neighborhood) in Orlando, Florida. While student at Jones High School, he played football. He furthered his education by attending North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University in Greensboro, North Carolina. He graduated in 1957, where he earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Mathematics. He continued his studies completing a Mathematics and Science Grant with the National Science Foundation at the University of Wyoming in Laramie, Wyoming during the summer of 1969. He also attended Rollins College in Winter Park, Florida where he graduated and earned a Master of Education Degree in

Mathematics in 1976.

His Journey of Love and Family

Joe met the love of his life, Annie Beatrice Smith in September of 1958. The two were joined together in Holy Matrimony on December 22, 1959. To this union, three lovely children were born: Tanya Lynette Burns, JoAnne Burns Green, and Joseph Burns, Jr. and they were blessed with 60 years of marriage.

Joe's love for mathematics and numbers inspired his daughters to follow in his footsteps also becoming math teachers within the Orange County Public Schools System.

Church Affiliations

Joseph Burns, Sr. was a member of Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Institutional Church in Orlando, Florida. A born again Christian, he served as Secretary/Treasurer of the Trustee Board, Sunday School Teacher, Member of the Special Chorus Choir, Voices of Zion Choir, BTU, Boy Scouts, and also Scout Master of Troop #87. He later joined St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church in Conway, where he was installed as a Deacon. He was a Member of the Mt. Moriah Missionary Baptist Church in Winter Park.

Professional Background

Joe worked in Orange County Public Schools teaching Mathematics for 40.6 years. His first teaching assignment was at Jones High School from 1958 to 1969. He left Jones High School during integration in 1970 and taught at Mid-Florida Technical Institute from 1970 until 1993. He left Mid-Florida Tech in 1993 and taught mathematics at the Orange County Jail (33rd Street Jail) from 1994 until 1998. Mr. Burns retired from Orange County Public Schools in 1998. He tutored with the McKnight Center of Excellence through the University of Central Florida and was also an Income Tax Practitioner.

Professional Affiliations and Memberships

Joe's love for education and mathematics garnered numerous memberships and awards such as: the Classroom Teachers Association (CTA), CTA Retired, National Education Association (NEA), NEA Retired, American Federation of Teachers (AFT), Phi Delta Kappa, Masonic Lodge, NAACP Orlando Branch, Jones High School Historical Society, Jones High School Alumni Association, North Carolina A & T Alumni Association, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Chi Tau Chapter. As a member of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. Joe was one of four brothers who crossed over in 1964 being the 2nd line of the Chi Tau Chapter in Orlando, Florida.

Deacon Joseph Burns, Sr. was preceded in death by his parents: Deacon Benjamin Burns, Sr. and Sister Annie Williams Burns; and siblings: Dorothy Burns-McDuffie, King Burns, Benjamin Burns, Jr., Carolyn Burns-Jones and Thelma Burns-Williams.
