Joyce Louise Miller was born on May 15th, 1938 in Saint Ann, Jamaica W.I. to parents, R.E. Grant and Myrtle Rose.

Joyce received her formal training as a nurse in London, England. She briefly emigrated to Toronto, Canada and then finally to the United States in 1963 to practice her profession and to further her education. She earned her Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Community Health Education while residing in New Jersey.

As a registered nurse, Joyce was employed at various hospitals during her long career; including as a Head Nurse at the Presbyterian Hospital and as Director of the multi-campus Newark Community Health Centers. Inc, both located in Newark, New Jersey. After relocating to Lawrenceville, Georgia, she worked as a Registered Nurse at Northside Hospital Gwinnett

(Formerly-Gwinnett County Medical Center) in Lawrenceville, Georgia.

Joyce received many recognitions and awards for her work in healthcare notably

a recipient of the YM/YWCA Black Achiever in Healthcare in Newark and vicinity, in the mid-1990s, and a Nursing Excellence award in Lawrenceville, Georgia - recognizing her excellence to the Nursing profession. However, one of her proudest accomplishments was earning her Nursing and Master's degrees, and going on to be one of the driving forces behind the forming and growth of the Jamaican Nurses Association of New Jersey, where she served as its first President.

Joyce was a devout Christian and was a member of several congregations in her lifetime, including First Presbyterian Church of Metuchen, New Jersey and Christ the King Baptist Church in Dacula, Georgia. Most recently, she was a member of Pleasant View Baptist Church in Apopka, Florida. She enjoyed reading the scripture and singing old hymns as a member of the church choir. Joyce dedicated her life to Christ and was always a very active member of the church throughout her lifetime.

Joyce was an avid gardener and relished being outside in her yard talking to God while working the soil. She was also an accomplished bowler and an active participant on her bowling team, with trophies to show for it! She loved to share her favorite hobby with her grandchildren, which she did as often as she could, until her health could no longer support it.

Joyce was married to Welton Miller for 45 years and they resided in New Jersey, Georgia, Texas, and finally Apopka, Florida. She was preceded in death by her mother, father and her sister, Hazel Patterson. She leaves to cherish her memory...her husband, Welton Miller; her son, Grant Miller; her daughter-in-law, Maria Miller; her sisters: Grace Pringle and Karen McKenzie; her brothers: Victor Osbourne, Samuel Grant, and Morris Grant; and grandchildren, Kevin Miller, Mason Miller, Isabella Miller, and Madelyn Miller; as well as a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, relatives, and friends.
