Rev. Dr. Judy Walker was born to Mary (Cookie) F. Harris and Willie B. Harris on April 13, 1961 in Orlando, Florida. Judy attended Oak Ridge High School; where she was a cheerleader and crowned the first African American Homecoming queen in 1978-79.

She furthered her education by attending Florida A&M University; where she received her bachelor's degree in criminal justice. Judy also earned a Master of Science degree from Nova Southeastern University and a Doctorate in Ministry from Jacksonville Theological Seminary. She is a member of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. She was licensed with the Church of God, Cocoa, Florida office in 2019 as an Ordained Licensed Minister.

Serve Others

Food delivery car service became a passion of hers over the past few years. She was so committed to pick up and deliver to Seniors, what was available for her without hesitation.

Judy always wanted to have things nice for family time dinners, lunches, Christmas parties, etc. They always included main ingredients games, large quantity of foods and free gifts for everyone in attendance.

Accept your Faith Foundation: A child of God. Yes! Judy accepted the Lord Jesus as her savior at an early age. It was during the era that asking Jesus to save you at every service and during every altar call was a must. She obeyed. Judy was a member of the West Livingston Street in Orlando, Florida for over 59 years. There she secured spiritual trainings from birth until adulthood. She ushered, sang in the 50 + member youth choir, led songs, participated in Joy

Bells, vacation bible school and Sunday school. As an adult, she stepped into the level of her calling and quickly began to minister to the needs while operating prophetically with the gifts of healing messages. Judy served in various capacities to include: A Minister, Church Announcer, an Evangelist, Sunday School Teacher, Girls Club Counselor, Youth Counselor, Vacation Bible School Assistant and Choir Member. In 2017, Judy was ordained as minister and loved to preach the gospel.

Judy Harris Walker, a uniquely gifted woman of God, was a born leader for all. She knew that things had to be Done and Right. She never questioned if she could do it or wondered who would do if she did not. Going to the top and being there was the direction of preferred choice. She was truly an influential force in the kingdom of God, constantly seeking to free others in their lives by counseling, praying and being a champion of righteousness. Judy's life was a "Go-to Person." Her smiles and laughter came from seeing others enjoy the red carpet she would lay out for them. She would say "I know just what you need."

The last 13 year journey led Judy to embrace one of her favorite scriptures: "But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint" (Isa. 40:31). She prayed without ceasing (Thessalonians 5:17) and found her answer in God's eternal Healing Plan of Peace. No more suffering. Just Praising God all day long.
