Junie (JouJou) Lafosse-Fontus was born Junie Lafosse on December 31, 1966, in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. She was the beloved daughter of the late Georgette Jean-Louis and Joseph Lafosee. In 1974, Junie and her family moved to Cite Militaire, where she formed lifelong friendships at Ecole Jesus Enfant. A bright and determined student, she excelled academically, always striving for excellence while spreading kindness and joy with her wonderful sense of humor. She continued her education at College Classique Feminin (CCF) and College Canado Haïtien (CCH), later becoming a manager at OAVCT in Port-au-Prince.

In April 1996, Junie and her sister Margarett immigrated to the United States in pursuit of a new life and opportunities. Upon arriving to Orlando, Florida, she faced numerous challenges but met them with resilience and determination. She initially worked as a housekeeper at the Rosen Hotel, but soon decided to pursue a career in healthcare. Junie attended nursing school and became a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), later advancing to become a

CNA Instructor, dedicating her life to helping others. In March 1998, Junie welcomes her greatest joy, her daughter Krishna T. Pierre, whom she cherished deeply. She also embraces a new role as a loving stepmother to Fabrice and became a cherished wife to Niki Fontus upon their marriage in August of 2020. Over the years, she achieved many milestones, earning her Real Estate license and devoted years to working as a state employee at the Florida Department of Health, serving and making a meaningful impact in her community.

In 2023, Junie was diagnosed with endometrial cancer. Despite her valiant fight, undergoing surgery and chemotherapy, she was later diagnosed with peritoneal cancer in 2024. For two years, she battled and faced this disease with unwavering faith, courage, and determination, supported by her devoted family and friends.

Junie will be remembered as a pillar of strength, love, and unity. She was a beacon of light among her family and friends. She was the glue that brought people together, making every gathering special with her warmth, wisdom, and legendary home-cooked Haitian meals. Her kitchen was a place of comfort for all where stories were shared over dishes made with love, and no one was ever left hungry. Junie's friendships spanned decades and continents, enriched by her genuine care and thoughtfulness. Junie had an extraordinary ability to welcome and cherish those around her, leaving an indelible mark on countless lives. Junie was the heart and soul of her family.

Our beloved Junie Lafosse-Fontus departed this life on January 27, 2025, after a courageous battle with cancer. She was 58 years old.

Junie was preceded in death by her Father, Joseph Lafosse; Mother, Georgette Jean Louis; and Sisters, Carlene Senat and Josline Renee. Junie

leaves behind a legacy of love, resilience, and generosity. She is survived by her beloved Husband, Niki Fontus of Orlando, Florida; her beloved Daughter, Krishna T. Pierre of Orlando, Florida; and her Stepson, Fabrice Fontus of Orlando, Florida.
