Kay Frances Swift was born on January 27, 1947 in Cluster Springs, Virginia to Annie Frances Miller and John Henry Miller. She graduated from Mary Bethune High School in South Boston, VA.

After graduating from high school, she relocated to Brooklyn, New York; where she pursued employment as a Key Punch Operator at the New York Stock Exchange.
