



## Lawrence L. Jones

May 27, 1943 - May 6, 2020

Lawrence Lee Jones was born the second child to Jethro Jones and Mamie Lee Blackman on May 27, 1943 in Tampa, Florida.

At an early age, Lawrence was baptized and later became a member of Open Door Missionary Baptist Church in Eatonville, Florida under the pastoral leadership of Reverend Charlie Banks. He was the Chairman of the Trustee Board until 2019 when he became ill.

Lawrence was inducted as a Mason into the Williams Edwards Lodge, Lodge #22 of Eatonville, Florida in 1985.

During his early years, he worked as a longshoreman. He eventually started his own painting contracting business, which he owned and operated until the early 90's.

Lawrence was preceded in death by his wife, Beulah Robinson Jones; parents: Jethro Jones and Mamie Lee Blackman; brother, Ronald Thomas, Sr.; son, Lorin Jones; and one brother-in-law.
