



Layune V. Scott "LAY"

Layune Scott, born on February 14, 1956, to Joseph and Mary Scott, peacefully departed this life on February 19, 2026, in Orlando, Florida. Raised in a loving Christian home, Layune accepted Christ at an early age and was a devoted member of Mt. Olive A.M.E. Church.

In 1974, Layune graduated from Maynard Evans High School and began her career at the Orlando Sentinel as an Administrative Assistant, where she dedicated fifteen years of service. Her role included scheduling travel arrangements, managing correspondence, and supporting management with special events and meetings. Layune later worked for the Florida Newspaper Advertising Network, The Home Mag, and Kforce Staffing, contributing her talents for an additional ten years. She briefly served the Orange County School Board before retiring in March of 2021. Layune's health began to decline shortly after her retirement, and she required assistance in her later years.

She is preceded in death by: her father, Joseph Scott Sr.; her aunt, Magnolia Wright; and her grandparents, Jessie and Eddie Scott, and Frank and Daisy Jones.
