Bishop Leroy McMillon of Apopka, Florida, was a dutiful and resilient servant of the Lord. The fourth of eleven children, he was born on February 27, 1946, in Pompano Beach, Florida, to the late Hardric McMillon, Sr. and the late Jannie Bell Grisham McMillon. A loving brother, he kept his siblings close to his heart and treasured the moments they spent together.

Bishop McMillon was united in Holy Matrimony to Missionary Gloria Jean Burrell McMillon in 1969. Their union spanned more than thirty-three wonderful years, until her untimely passing, and was blessed with six children, whom he taught to love and revere the Lord.

For sixty years, Bishop McMillon devoted his life to the Lord. His deep love for the Word of God led him to become an ordained minister in the Church of God in Christ. Alongside his wife, Apostle Valeria Butts McMillon, he faithfully served for sixteen years as pastor of God's House Ministries. Together, they built not only a congregation, but also a loving community—known as “the church with the big heart”—committed to reflecting the love of Jesus Christ and exemplifying holiness.
