Louis Cornelius Pinellas, Jr., was born on November 25, 1942 in Eustis, Florida to the late Louis Cornelius Pinellas, Sr., and Dorothy M. Anderson.

In his early life Louis became a member of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church, Kissimmee, Fla., where he accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior. In his later years he joined St Luke Missionary Baptist church, Narcoossee, Florida.

In 1979, he met and courted, Annie "Lou" Pinellas, until he asked for her hand in marriage. On June 26, 1981, they were married. With this union came a tribe of sons and daughters, and they quickly became a large loving, blended

family. Louis accepted Annie's kids as his own and she accepted his. A few years later, in October of 1984, that union would bring another child, the very last of the bunch, Lambert "Spud" Pinellas.

He was employed at Desota Paint Company for over 10 years, where he mastered the art of painting, he took great pride in painting and manifesting a strong work ethic, meticulous preparation and paying close attention to detail to achieve a flawless finish. Making a career change he later took on the job of being Facilities Technician until retirement. He continued painting until his health started to decline.

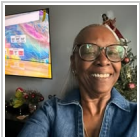
