Louissteen Daniels Cummings was born to late Louis Daniels and Gussie Mae Johnson on September 22, 1946, in Quincy, Florida. The family relocated to Eatonville, Florida, in September 1954. She graduated from Hungerford High School in 1965 in Eatonville, Florida. Seeking higher education, she attended Hampton Junior College in Ocala, Florida, and majored in Business Administration. Louissteen began her Christian journey at Open Door Missionary Baptist Church and later joined Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church in Eatonville, Florida, where she served faithfully until her death.

In September 1973, Louissteen began her career at Winter Park Telephone Company as a long-distance operator, where she forged meaningful connections with her colleagues. Throughout the company's transitions to United Telephone, Sprint, Embarq, and CenturyLink, she remained a steadfast contributor to its achievements. Her dedicated service culminated in her retirement as a Business Representative in October 2010.

Louissteen had a dedication to God, family, and community, as well as the

Historic Town of Eatonville (1887) and the Gamma Phi Delta Sorority, Inc., Eatonville Chapter. Louissteen belonged to a plethora of organizations, nonprofits, and volunteer groups.

She genuinely prioritized the welfare of others. It was customary for her to prepare complete meals for grieving families, provide food for the less fortunate, and offer clothing to those lacking, all without seeking anything in return. Acting as a community ambassador, she effortlessly connected individuals with the necessary resources, making it her mission to assist everyone she encountered.

Louissteen departed this life on the evening of Friday, March 22, 2024, to enter God's promise of Eternal Life. Preceding her in death are: her parents, Louis Daniels and Gussie Johnson; her Brothers, James Daniels, Cleveland Daniels, Richard Daniels, and Sister, Floree Rivers and Viola Daniels.

Louissteen was also named the "Champion Recruiter" for the chapter.

Louissteen served as the chapter liaison for the Town of Eatonville. If there was anything required of us from the town, she would ensure that we knew and followed the rules. She was affectionately called "Miss Eatonville" by her sister.

Louissteen always strived to reach new heights in Gamma Delta Chapter forever ready to assist others at all costs with kindness and love.
