Mrs. Mamie Lee McMillon Rolle daughter of the late Mr. Dennis McMillon, Sr. and Mrs. Minnie Mae Linder McMillon was born on September 19, 1931 in Smoaks, (Carlton County) South Carolina. As a youth, her parents along with her brother moved to Daytona Beach, Florida so that their children could have a better education. At a very young age Mamie gave her life to Christ becoming a member of Greater Friendship Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Jenkins. In Daytona Beach, Florida.

Mamie L. Rolle attended the segregated school system of Volusia County. She graduated with honors from Campbell Senior High School and was crowned Miss Campbell Senior High School. Mamie attended Florida Agriculture and Mechanical University. While attending college, Mamie met the love of her life Mr. Rudolph Rolle. After receiving their degrees in education, the two married and moved to Pleasant, California. While Mr. Rolle

served in the United States Army, their daughter Candyce was born. Shortly thereafter, their second child Aletia Rolle was born to their union which lasted 57 years.

Mamie and her family left California and relocated to Eustis, Florida where she began her career within the Lake County Public Schools System. She served as a secretary at Curtwright Vocational High School and then went on to teach at Umatilla Elementary School. Mamie was a life time member of Gethsemane Baptist Church, where she served under the leadership of Reverend of Reverend William Hawkins Sr. until her health declined.

Mamie was one of the 5 founders of the Criterion Civic Club, Inc. of Eustis, Florida (chartered for 66 years). She was also a member of the Leesburg Alumni Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Incorporated where she was a member for 44 years and a member of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International Honor Society for Women Educators. She was also a member of the NAACP. Once retired Mamie Rolle continued to educate the youth of Eustis, Florida tutoring anyone who needed her help.

Mamie enjoyed her retirement traveling and enjoying family until her health began to fail.
