“ *Marilyn was born July 13, 1949 the eldest of four siblings the first born to both James P. Glymph and Styretha M.. Hooper in Cleveland, Oh where she was reared and raised. A young Marilyn destined to be a leader and a Matriarch gives self credit to the rearing and assistance of her younger siblings Patricia Callahan of Orlando, Fl and Beverly Callahan of Atlanta, Ga. Later in life young Marilyn would take on the challenge of attempting to further educate her brother Carlton Waddy who was at the time obtaining his own formal education in the school of "Hard Knocks". Marilyn attended Cleveland Public schools and had what she affectionately describes as a colorful childhood. Many would say that she had the best of both worlds but she'd beg to differ, Marilyn lived between many family members throughout her childhood life the majority being with the then Matriarch Mary and Bill Cunningham on E. 83rd and Quincy and E. 140th and Horner. The life within the Cunningham household gave Marilyn most of her zest and cultures her young mind in ways that one can only imagine. From Marilyn's perspective Mary Cunninghams home was the only structured portion of her life as they lived a very affluent lifestyle for blacks and they were very politically connected within the Cleveland Republican community. Once Marilyn had decided that she'd had enough of playing school she decided to sign herself out and take the GED, no sense in wasting anymore time, after all time was money. She and her sister Dorothy had other ideas about life and Cleveland would be there playground.*
