Martin P. Francis, a beloved soul was born on November 12, 1932 on the island of Trinidad to parents George Patrick and Loretta Francis.

On March 12, 1971, Martin embarked on a journey of love and commitment when he united in marriage with his devoted wife, Georgia Francis. His wife passed March 14, 2022. A steadfast husband and caring father, Martin leaves a legacy of familial warmth and unwavering support.

Martin's professional journey was marked by establishing his cabinetmaking business and a twenty six year tenure in the Engineering department at Florida Hospital, Orlando (now known as Advent Health) as a master cabinetmaker, retiring in 2006. Beyond his professional achievements, Martin was an active and dedicated Mt. Olive SDA church member. He served as the Head Elder, Sabbath School Superintendent, Leader of the Personal Ministries department, Prison Ministry Leader, Community Services Team Members, and AYS Leader.
