Mr. Mathis Harden was born May 17, 1930 in Rhine, Georgia. He was one of twenty-one children born to the late Matt and Perry Lee Harden.

Mathis married the love of his life, Roxie Battle in 1953 and relocated to Florida in 1956. Mathis was employed for many years by the Winter Garden Citrus Growers Association. He later worked for and retired from Orange County Public Schools.

Mathis joined the Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church Family shortly after moving to Florida. Mathis was a dedicated member of Bethlehem, serving faithfully in several capacities: The Male Chorus (founding member), The Mass Choir, The Brotherhood Ministry and the Senior Usher Board until his health began to fail him. Mathis was also a member of the Masonic (Macedonia) Lodge #49.

Mathis was a calm and quiet man who loved the Lord and his family. He spent the last 18 years of his life with his son Willie and his family in Geneva, Florida where he is already truly missed. On Friday, May 24, 2024, one week after his 94 th birthday, Mathis slept away peacefully at home.
