Miles Lee Pollock was born December 11, 1939 in Bascom, Jackson County, Florida to the parentage of Jessie Marion Pollock and Roberta Leeks Pollock. He was the fifth sibling of eight children.

Miles entered public school in Bascom and upon completing first grade, the family moved to Leesburg, Florida; where he continued his studies. The family then moved to Zellwood, Florida and Miles continued his education at Zellwood Elementary School. He later went on to further his schooling at Phyllis Wheatley High School.

Miles' father was a contractor for various citrus companies in Florida and he would work with his father during the summer in the northern states of Virginia, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania and North Carolina. It provided the opportunity for Miles to mature early and become a very strong man, with strong determination about his life. He was a faithful worker.

Miles stood firm on his beliefs and generosity was his main trait. He would share his best with those in need, not expecting or demanding repayment, he shared from his heart. Miles retired from the occupation he loved...truck driving. His big truck was his friend, his comfort, his livelihood and his joy! An issue with his vision was what brought the end to his "driving for a living".

Miles showed himself friendly and had many friends. He was a friend that “loved at all times”! His heart became even the more generous after giving it to Jesus Christ, through salvation in December of 1998. His love, outreach and joy in the Lord was helping people. Miles joyfully, unselfishly, generously, and frequently shared his resources and joy in the Lord.
