Moiel was born in Tortola, British Virgins Islands to Richard and Rosetta Hodge - fourth of their children

From childhood, Moiel was introduced to the Saviour Jesus Christ and His Church by her Parents. And all the days of her life, she Believed and Served the Lord Jesus Christ as her Saviour.

After graduating from the 'Seventh Day Adventist High School' - Moiel began her very lengthy Nursing Career in both Private and Public Hospitals for the Virgin Islands, while receiving additional 'Operating Room' training in the USA. Moiel utilized her surgical skills as an Operating Room Nurse in both General Surgery and Comsetic Surgery. And at the same time, she continued her long and dedicated service to the Church and to her Family.

Moiel married Banker and Local Preacher - Christian Malvin Dawson. And that union gave birth to a son - Shawn. Her husband later retired from Banking, and moved the Family to Orlando, Florida. And there in Orlando, Moiel continued her Nursing Career at other Healthcare Facilities by skillfully caring for the sick and infirmed.

The Family immediately became Members of the 'Orlando Christian Center - (OCC)', where she served in the areas of being a 'Choir Member', and also as

a long serving 'Full Time Prayer Partner' for the Ministry. there, Moiel prayed of the countless individuals who called the Ministry for Prayer, and also for a 'listen-ing ear' to offer comfort and strength.

This was the 'crown' of her life - Ministering to the whole man - spirit, soul and body. This meant for her, a Ministry of Prayer, Encouragement, Sharing the Word of God, and leading the Penitent in a Personal Relationship with Saviour Jesus Christ.

Moiel continued her service to the Lord Jesus Christ at other Churches in Orlando as well - while she and her close friends: Mrs. Evelyn Christopher and Cynthia Scott teamed up together and pooled their resources to feed and minister to many of the Homeless on the streets of Orlando - all for the glory and Kingdom of God - and with the words of Jesus Christ in Matthew 25:40 in the forefront of their minds-" ... Inasmuch as you have done it unto one of these my brethren, you have done it unto Me.

Being restricted by COVID19, Moiel's Worship Services took place at home with her husband - until her illness that lead to her untimely death. Her passing was the entrance and graduation to her 'New Life and Eternal Home in Heaven' - the Final Meeting Place for all Followers of Jesus Christ - Son of the Living God.

So we say: Dear Sister 'We will soon be seeing you in the Morning -where we will meet to part no more'.
