Mary Juanita Massie was born in Hopkinsville, Kentucky on October 11, 1920 to Houston and Clara Massie. She professed her love for Christ at an early age and was a faithful member of Union Evangelistic Missionary Baptist Church for 86 years. During her time at Union, she led and participated in several ministries. The Up & Doing Club, Hannah Circle, and the afterschool tutorial just to name a few. Mary received her education in the Chicago Heights School System. She also attended Madame C.J. Walker School of Cosmetology in Chicago, Illinois.

In 1942, she met and married William L. Bouler and they became members of the Chicago Heights Couples Club. To this union five children were born. Mary was a Homemaker until she chose to further her education and eventually went to work at Rich Central High School for several years in the Title One Reading Program. During her years at Rich Central, she mentored several students, who to this day STILL refer to her as “Mother” or “Mother Bouler.”

In 2006, William and Mary relocated to Winter Garden, Florida which is the birthplace of William. They immediately became active members of West Orlando Christian Center where they belonged to the Couples Ministry and

she was also a Church Mother. She truly loved her Church Family and they shared her feelings.

She was preceded in death by one son: William "Billy" Richard Boulter; her loving parents: Houston and Clara Massie; and two sisters: Jeanette Butler and Lilas Collins.

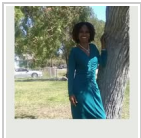
